Filing a Community College Reasonable Accommodation Complaint

Students with Disabilities – Take Action 4 Accommodations Campaign

If you have experienced delayed or denied accommodations at your California Community College, you can file a complaint with the United States Department of Education Office of Civil Rights for denial of your right to an equal education.

FILE YOUR COMPLAINT :

The Office for Civil Rights (OCR) is part of the Federal Department of Education. OCR investigates violations of Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act and Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act. Please note, complaints with the Office of Civil Rights must be filed within 180 days of the date that you were discriminated against, unless you have already gone through your school's internal grievance process. If you have gone through your school's grievance process you must file your OCR complaint within 60 days of the school's decision on your grievance.
